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Arrival at Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA):

How to reach Impiana KLCC Hotel from the main airport:



- Take KLIA Express from KLIA to KL Sentral (28 mins, RM55).
- Book a Taxi or GrabCar from KL Sentral to Impiana KLCC Hotel (6 km, 10 mins, RM9-RM15).

Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA):

Study visit

Study Tour - Friday, 30 May 2025

The study tour is scheduled for **Friday, 30 May 2025**, from **8:30 AM to 4:30 PM**. This tour provides participants with the opportunity to explore cutting-edge technologies in TVET, including AI and VR/AR tools, during a visit to **Community College Selayang** in Selangor. Additionally, the delegation will visit **the Craft**

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Museum and Craft Complex, Kuala Lumpur for a glimpse into Malaysia's rich artistic traditions. Participants can observe demonstrations of intricate crafts like batik painting and weaving, gaining insight into the specialized skills involved.

Participants are advised to dress comfortably and wear comfortable shoes to avoid fatigue and accidents.

- **KLIA Express** offers a fast train service between the airport and the city.

Location

- **Official Name** – Malaysia
- **Capital** – Kuala Lumpur
- **Head of Government** – Prime Minister Dato' Seri Anwar Ibrahim

Languages:

Malay (Bahasa Malaysia) is the official language. English is widely spoken, plus other local languages.

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Climate/Weather

- In late May 2025, Kuala Lumpur will be hot and humid. Daytime temperatures will range from **32°C** to **25°C at night**. Expect **occasional rain showers** and **high humidity**.

Malaysia Standard Time GMT+8 (UTC+8)

- Plug type: Type G (three rectangular prongs)



- **Currency:**
Malaysia's currency is the Malaysian Ringgit (RM or MYR)
1 USD ≈ RM4.70 (*subject to change*).
- **Communication:**
The Internet country code top-level domain (ccTLD) for **Malaysia** is **.my**.
Government websites use **.gov.my** educational institutions use **.edu.my**.

The internet is widely available via **fiber, mobile data, DSL, and Wi-Fi** in hotels, cafes, and public areas.

- **Ways to access the Internet:**
 1. Activate a **virtual eSIM** with your phone.
 2. Buy a **Malaysian SIM card** online before arrival or upon landing.
 3. Purchase a **prepaid SIM card** at the airport or from mobile providers (e.g., Celcom, Digi, Maxis).

COVID-19 requirements

- A COVID-19 vaccination certificate is NOT required to enter Malaysia.
- No testing or quarantine is needed unless symptomatic.
- If you have flu-like symptoms, **wear a mask** and **seek medical care** if needed.

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Check your passport and travel documents before you travel

Passport validity

- All participants must hold a passport valid for at least **six (6) months** upon arrival in Malaysia.
- Visa requirements depend on nationality.

Visas

Visas must be obtained from **Malaysian Embassies/High Commissions** or Consulates before travel, **unless you are from a visa-exempt country**.

- **Visa on Arrival** is available for certain nationalities under specific conditions (e.g., arriving from Thailand, Singapore, Indonesia).
- Participants are advised to **check visa requirements** based on their nationality before departure.
- Keep your **boarding passes** for immigration checks, if requested.
