Partnership for Excellence

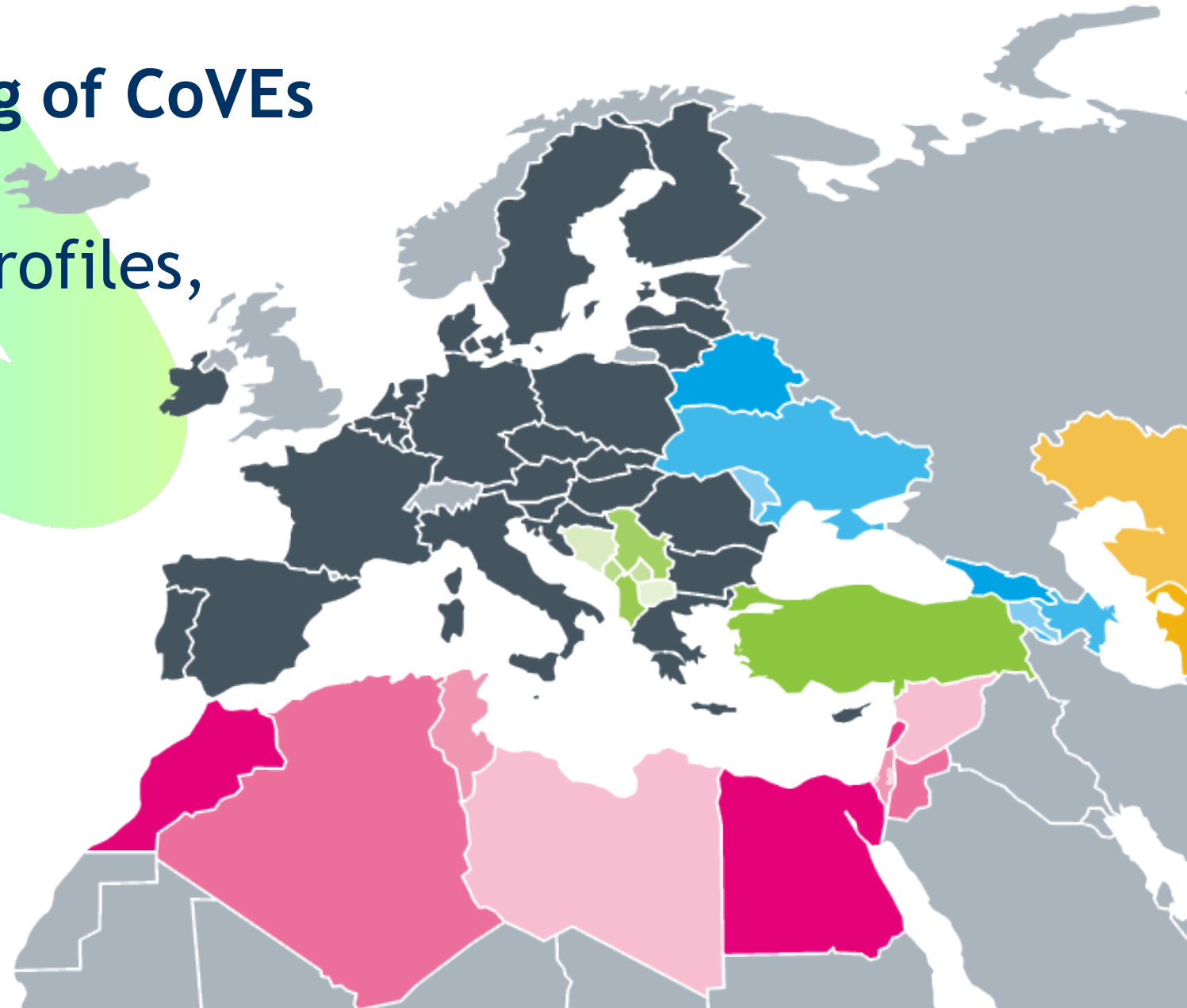

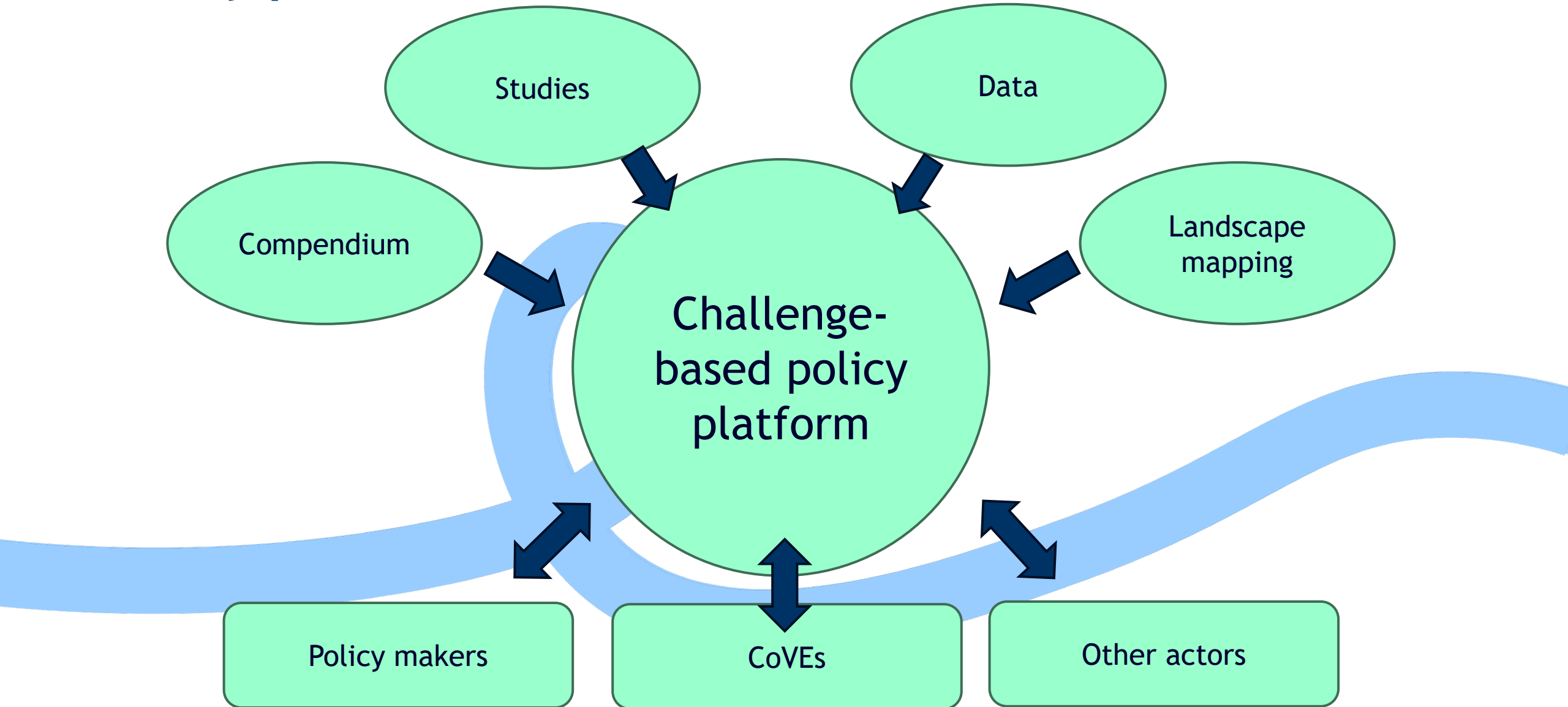
