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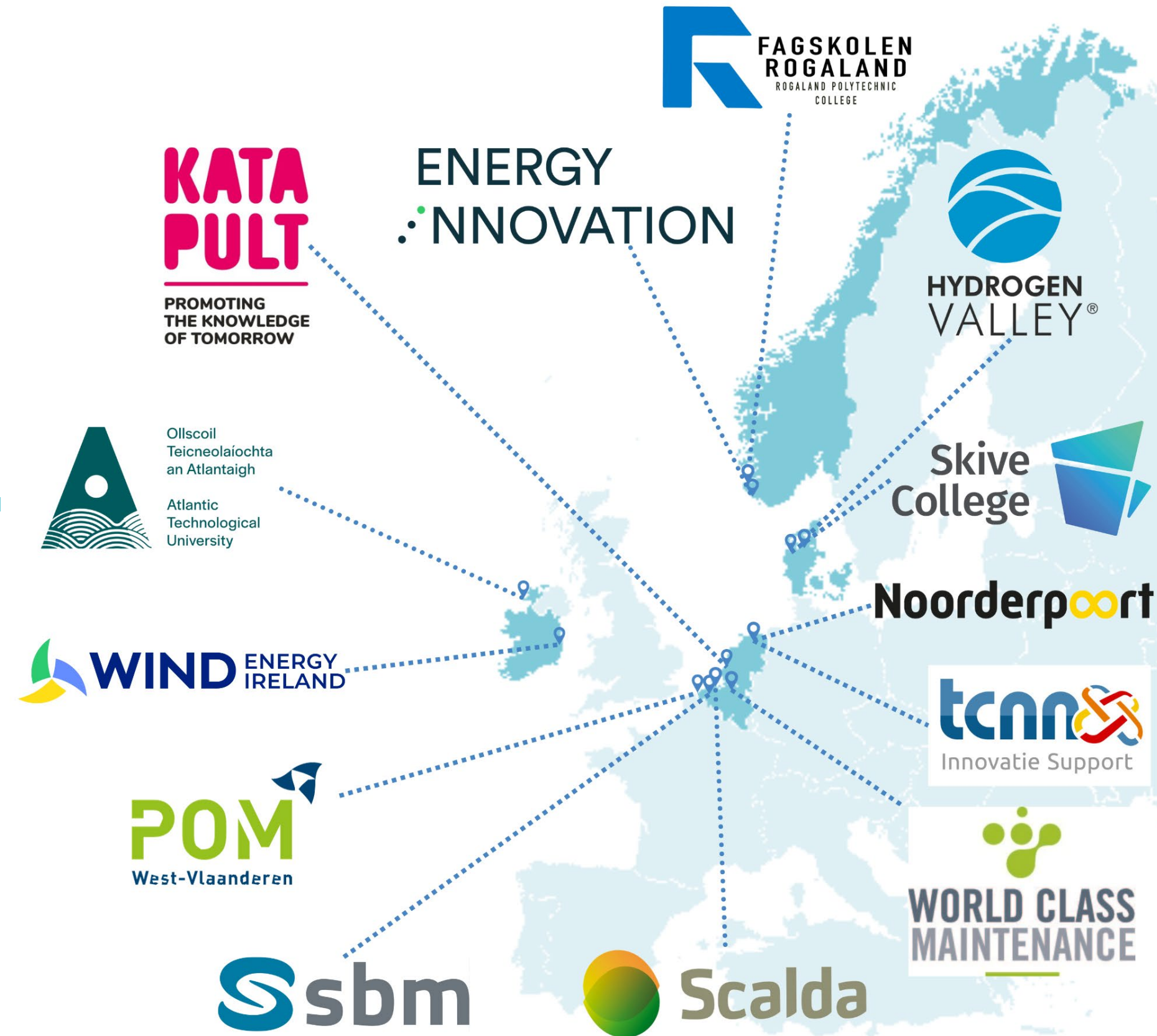

T-shore CoVE for Offshore Wind Energy

- A harmonised entry level training programme will be developed that are tailored to the needs of employers in the offshore wind industry.
- A training library will be created that can be used by CoVEs across the EU.
- CoVEs will be established across the EU to provide hands-on training and support for workers in the offshore wind industry.
- A 'Train the Trainer' programme will be established to increase the capabilities of VET school trainers.
- Industry collaboration will be fostered to ensure that the training programmes and CoVEs meet the needs of employers in the offshore wind industry.

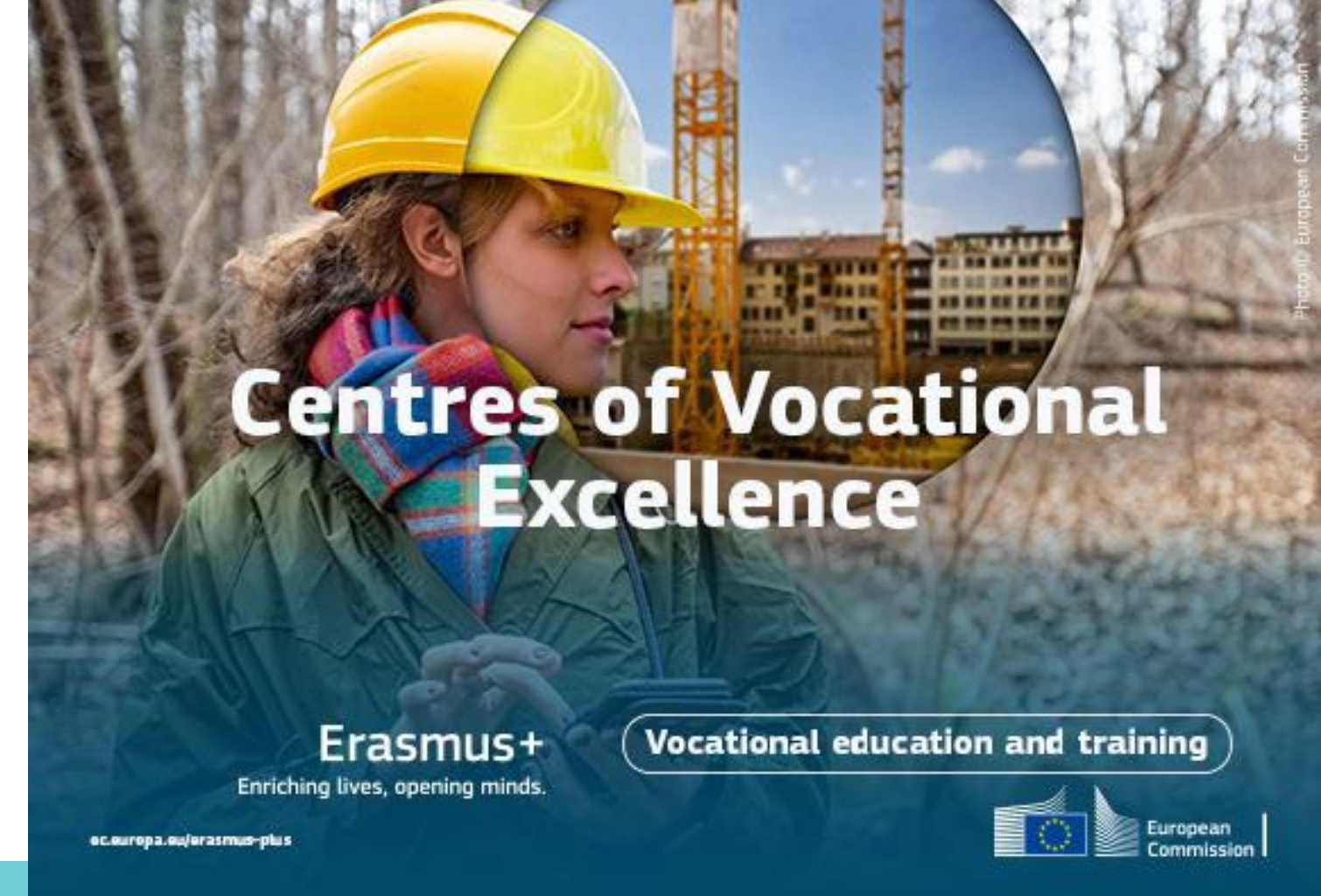

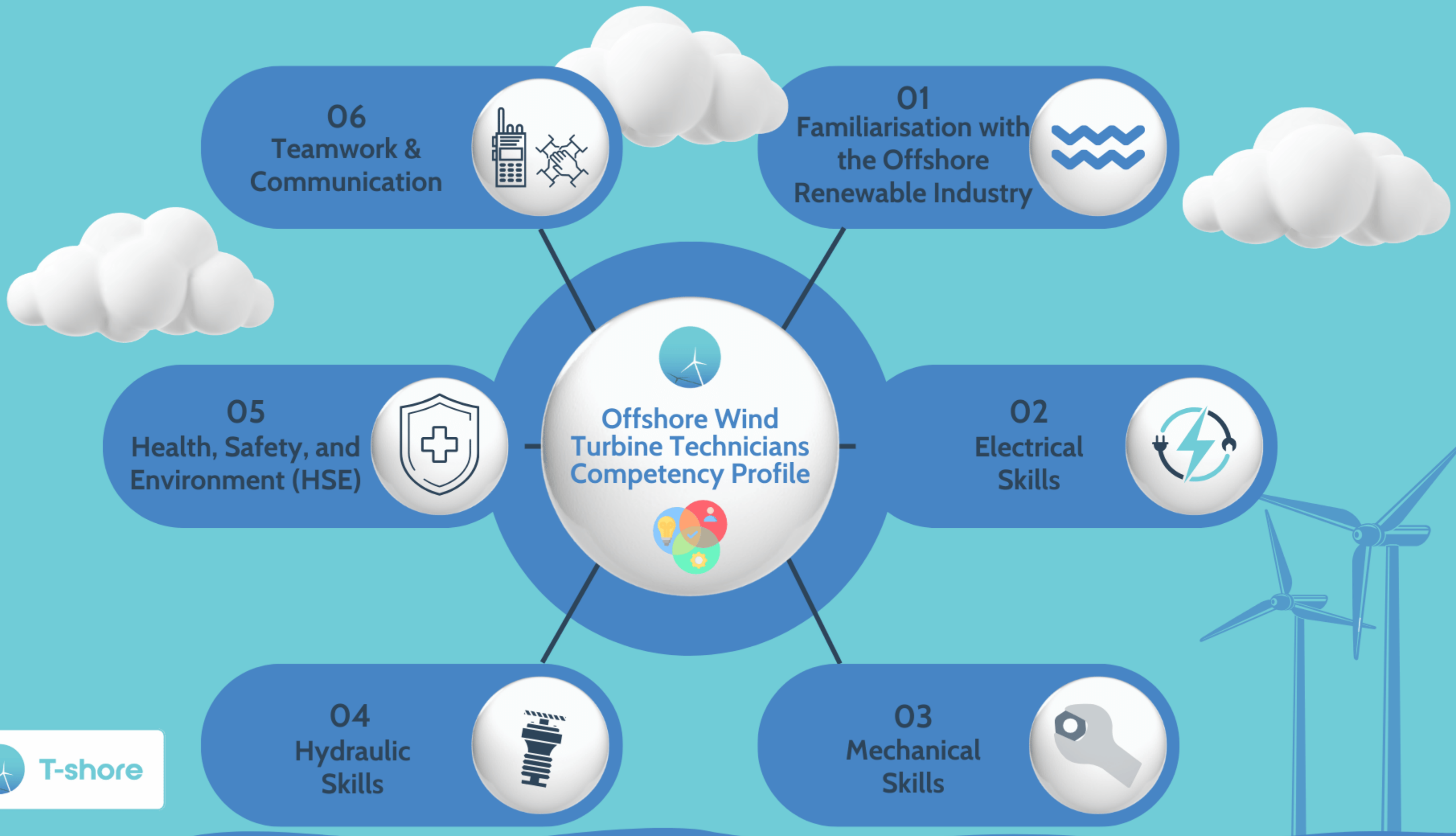

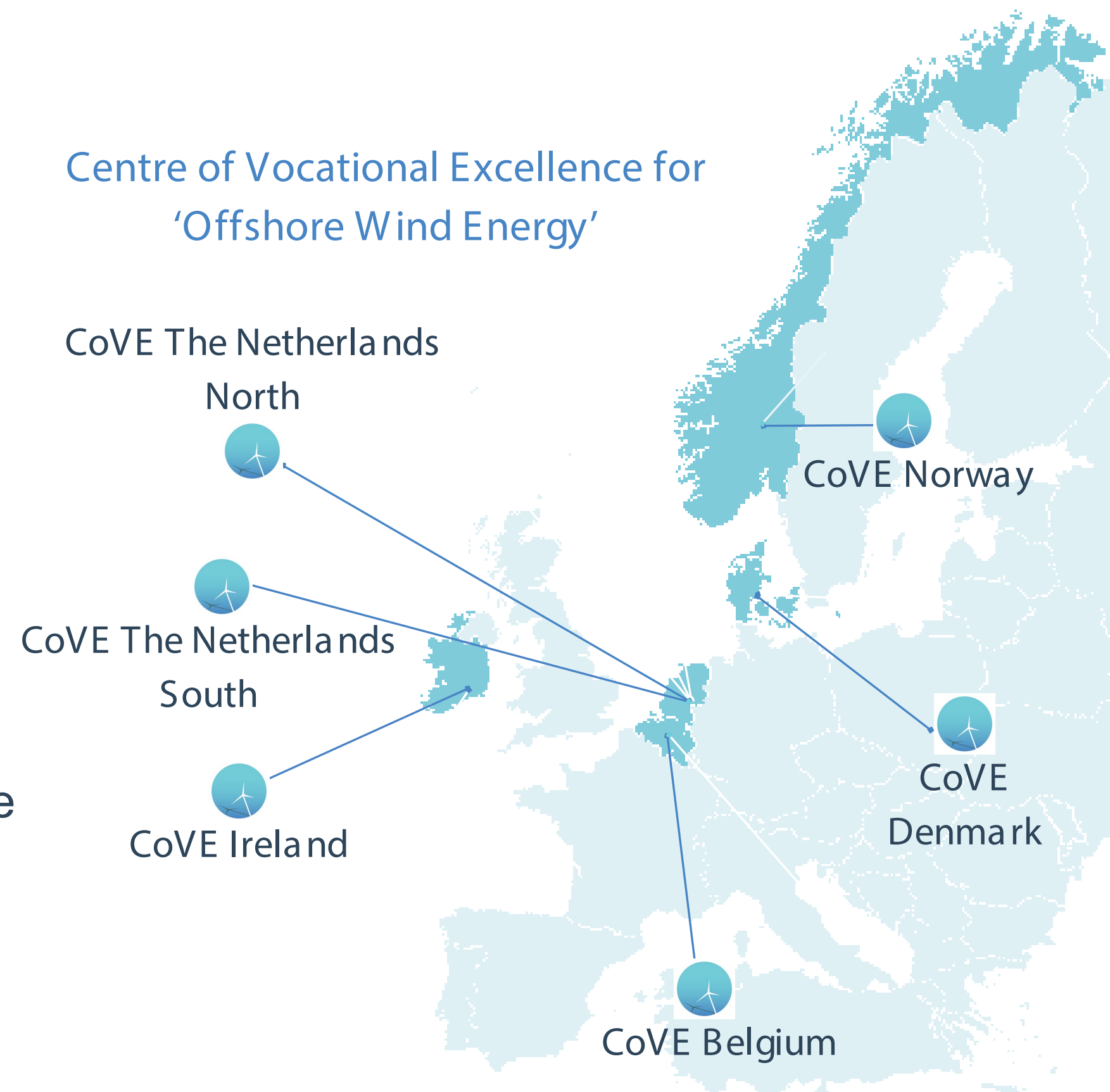
